Code of Conduct for Children

**For the purposes of this Code of Conduct, "snow sport" incorporates all club Cross Country Skiing, Telemarking and Roller Skiing activities.*

Children taking part in activities at **Manchester Cross Country Ski Club** should:

- Arrive promptly for snowsport* activities and allow enough time to be ready to start at the agreed time.
- Dress appropriately for the activity and weather conditions including gloves and helmet as directed by their coaches.
- Show respect and courtesy to coaches and officials at all times and understand that taking part in snowsport* is only possible due to the time volunteers give freely to help themselves and other members.
- Try to listen to coaches and officials at all times
- Show respect and courtesy to other snowsport participants at all times.
- Abide by the club rules.
- Never be involved in any bullying or practices that can be deemed as bullying.
- Not use the internet, phone or other electronic device to make remarks about other people involved in snowsport, or clubs, or anything related to snowsport that could be considered wrong or unkind.
- Report any concerns they have to their coach, Club Welfare Officer or their parents.
- Demonstrate sporting behaviour in all their activities and promote good sportsmanship, being modest in victory and gracious in defeat.
